



Summary:

Under the Weekly Schedule tab there is an option to move or copy either specific or full weekly schedules over to a different week or team. In some cases, this might be used when outage dates change, or someone makes a mistake and does not select the applicable week or team when building out the schedule.

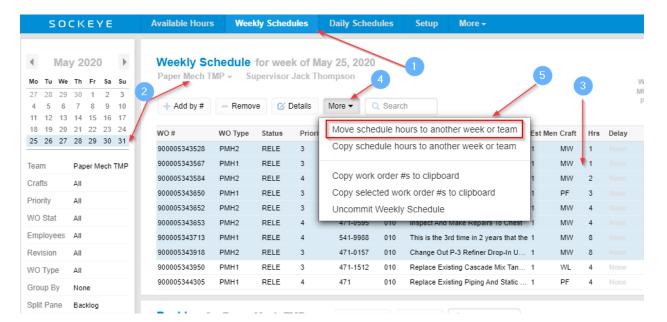
Weekly Schedule

Move scheduled work to another week or team:

Video Link: Move Work

Selecting 'Move schedule hours to another week or team' will transfer the work order and hour details to a different week or team. These work orders will no longer be in the week or team currently scheduled.

- 1. Click on Weekly Schedules tab in the blue ribbon at the top of your screen
- 2. Click on the Week and Team that is applicable
- 3. Select the work orders that are to be moved. Those selected will be highlighted in blue.
- 4. Click More ▼ under the Weekly schedule portion of the screen
- 5. Select 'Move Schedule hours to another week or team'

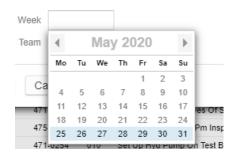

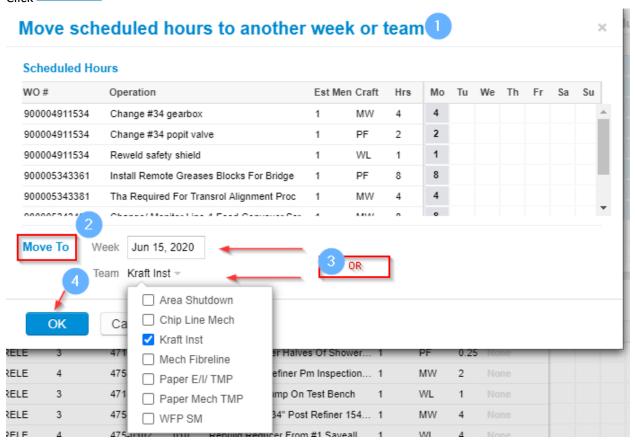
All work orders that were selected will show up for reference

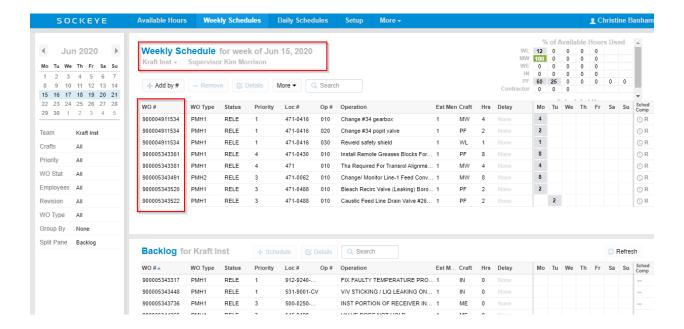

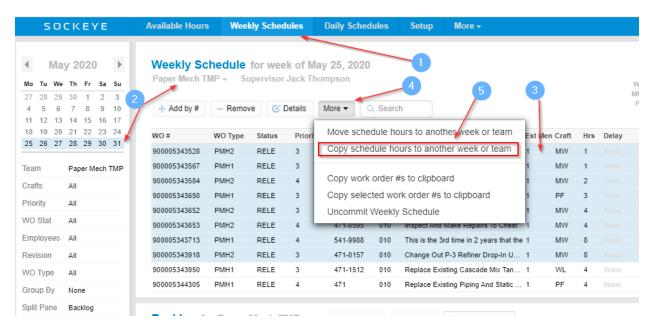


Copy scheduled work to another week or team:

Video Link: Copy Work

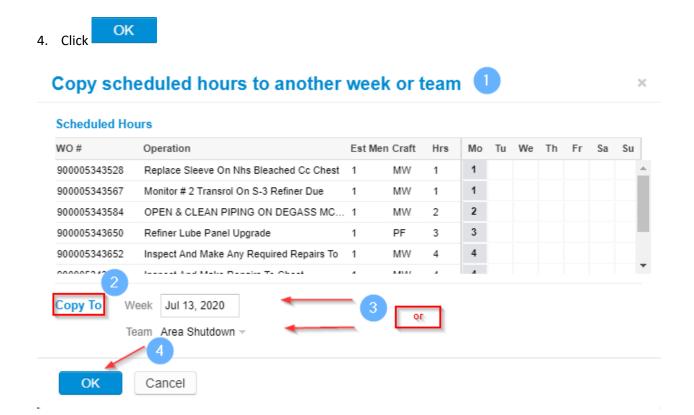
When selecting 'Copy schedule hours to another week or team' will add the selected work orders and hour details to a different week or team. These work orders will remain in the current week and team schedule.

- 1. Click on Weekly Schedules tab in the blue ribbon at the top of your screen
- 2. Click on the Week and Team that is applicable
- 3. Select the work orders that are to be moved. Those selected will be highlighted in blue.
- 4. Click More ▼ under the Weekly schedule portion of the screen
- 5. Select 'Copy Schedule hours to another week or team'

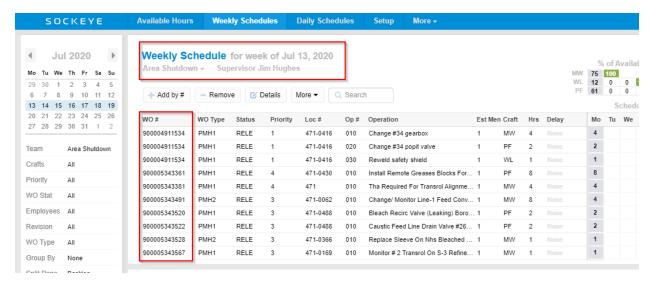


- 1. A box will appear called Copy scheduled hours to another week or team
